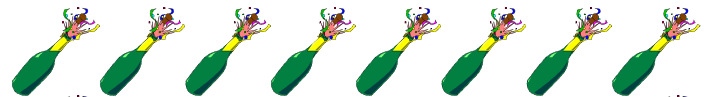


Trophy Reminder

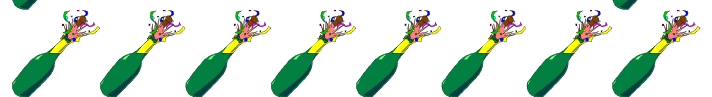
