Warm Weather

We are fortunate to have plenty of shady areas on the school site, and playground staff are very conscious of the dangers of extended exposure to direct sunlight. If your child needs sun cream to be applied, please do this in the morning. Speak to your child's form teacher if they need to have repeated applications during the day.

Toys

We have no objection to children bringing in small toys to play with during break times. Please do not allow your child to bring in large toys – we do not have space to store them, or expensive toys – we cannot take responsibility for their security.

We supply footballs for break times; this gives us some control over the number of games that are taking place, and when the children are on the playground, we use 'soft' footballs so that children do not get hurt. Children should not need to bring their own footballs into school.

Access to Classrooms

We leave our classrooms open in the morning so that the children can drop off their book bags before going to the top playground where they are supervised from 8.20am. If there are issues with the children's behaviour in the classrooms, we will have to lock them. I will be warning the children of this in Assembly.

We also like to give access to our parents so that they can view their child's work, or so that they can see their child's form teacher in a more private setting. If parents begin to congregate in classrooms, this prevents a parent having a private chat with a teacher, and there are also safeguarding issues concerned with adults and other people's children in classrooms! Please be aware of this and meet on the playground.
