Monday

After School Club Y3 & Y4

After School Club offers a range of activities including supervised outdoor play.
Cost: £65 per term (12 weeks) or no charge with ASCAPS

Junior Warhammer Club with Mr Sayer and Mr Wood Y3 & Y4

Warhammer is the world's leading table top game. Players battle using miniature models and practise their Maths skills by adding up dice rolls. We will focus on Warhammer 40,000 which sees different armies fight against each other for control of the galaxy. In the club, pupils will assemble, paint and play with the models. There will also be opportunities to create and paint scenery for use in the battles.

Maximum number: 10

Cost: £77 per term (12 weeks) or £12 with ASCAPS

Junior Crafty Aft Club with Potty Potter from The Clay Barn Pottery Y3 & Y4

Come along and experience lots of exciting crafts including decorating some fabulous pottery pieces to take home.

Cost: £113 per term (12 weeks) or £48 with ASCAPS

Pike/Chubb Fishing Club with Mr Edwards and Mr Campen Y5 to Y8

Children will learn how to fish for pike and chubb understanding techniques and habitat in particular. For the most part we will be using the School's stretch of the River Wensum in addition to Taverham Lakes. Importantly, you will need to be more than "fair weather" anglers given the weather will be very different to the Summer Term and therefore warm clothing and waterproofs will be essential. Fishing equipment would be desirable but not essential.

Please note the later finish time of 18:30 and that this hobby will ONLY run during the first half of the term due to light restrictions beyond this point.

Dance & Aerobics with Mrs Beedell Y5 to Y8

Senior Clay Pigeon Shooting Club with Mr Hoare Y6 to Y8

Clay pigeon shooting, also known as clay target shooting, is the art of shooting a firearm at special flying targets, known as clay pigeons or clay targets. Set in an attractive woodland setting, the Mid Norfolk Shooting School is widely recognised as an outstanding facility to sharpen shooting skills and take lessons from an expert instructor at a ratio of 1:7. Transport to and from the Shooting School will be provided in addition to gun hire and a minimum of 20 clays and cartridges for your use in each session. Gun storage can be arranged by contacting the Mid Norfolk Shooting Range directly. Please note this may incur an additional cost.

Whilst this hobby is open to Year 6, due to the nature of the sport and the weight of the guns, Year 6 children must have prior experience and be able to handle a 28-gauge shot gun independently. Mr Hoare will be happy to discuss this and assess it on an individual basis and has kindly asked that Year 6 parents interested in this hobby contact him directly at t.hoare@taverhamhall.co.uk Please note the later finish time of 18:30 and that this hobby will ONLY run for 3 weeks, up to and including 26 September 2019, due to licensing and daylight restrictions.
